

Harbor Beach Community Hospital Mental Health Services

What Providers Need to Know:



1. What types of mental health services does Harbor Beach Community Hospital provide?
 - Senior Life Solutions: Group therapy and individual counseling appointments are available to senior citizens age 65 and older. Participants must have Medicare and a secondary insurance to access services.
 - Integrated Behavioral Healthcare: The Harbor Beach Medical Clinic and Port Hope Medical Clinic have social workers working alongside the primary care providers. The social worker's role is to address patient's mental health concerns and offer brief intervention and support for those with chronic health conditions.
 - Tele-Psychiatry Services: Youth, adults, and senior citizens will be able to access psychiatry services through tele-psychiatry. Providers will offer brief intervention and medication management.
2. Who can utilize these services?

Services are available to Harbor Beach Community Hospital patients, as well as other individuals in need of mental health services throughout the region. There are no income guidelines or locational boundaries for receiving services.
3. What admission criteria do patients need to meet?

Patients should have mental health concerns to access services. Referrals are not required for individuals to seek services, however it is suggested that individuals check with their insurance provider to see if this is a covered benefit. Insurance copay or payment will be collected at the time of service.
4. Where can patients access these services at?

Harbor Beach Community Hospital patients may access Integrated Behavioral Health and/or Tele-psychiatry services through the Harbor Beach Medical Clinic or Port Hope Medical Clinic. Individuals who are not patients of Harbor Beach Community Hospital can receive Tele-psychiatry services at the Specialty Clinic (located at 234 S. in First St. Harbor Beach) or at the Tele-Psych Clinic (located within Professional Counseling Services at 128 W. Huron Ave. Suite C in Bad Axe).
5. What insurances does the Harbor Beach Community Hospital accept?

The Harbor Beach Community Hospital accepts Medicaid, Medicare, and various commercial insurances to help patients meet their healthcare needs. We advise patients to visit www.hbch.org and click on the "Patients" tab, then select "Patient Info" for the full list of insurance plans that Harbor Beach Community Hospital accepts. A patient should always check with his or her insurance provider prior to visits to see if outpatient therapy and /or tele-psychiatry services are covered, and/or if a referral is needed for you to seek services.
